Some ideas for Rotary Clubs on how they can be involved in National Skills Week 2017

- Invite an Australian Apprenticeships Ambassador or Australian Training Awards Alumni to speak
- Invite an apprentice who has completed their apprenticeship to talk to Rotarians about their experience
- Investigate school-based apprenticeships (what they are) invite a teacher from a High School to explain
- Organise a joint function with a TAFE institute and/or Registered Training Organisation (RTO), or member of ACPET
- Invite a representative from a Registered Training Organisation or Group Training Organisation to address Rotary
- Invite an employer organisation representative from the National Farmers' Federation, Australian Chamber of Commerce (ACCI) or Australian Industry Group (Ai Group) to address Rotary
- Invite a WorldSkills representative to talk to Rotarians about their experience
- Opportunities to be connected to Rotary Youth Programs such as RYLA, RYPEN, etc. by engaging with the many organisations and networks provided in this checklist
- Organise a father daughter dinner with a local High School or parent night for parents and their daughters to be addressed by successful women who have succeeded in non-traditional trades. For example, more women are going into engineering, electrical, building and construction, mining, and agriculture
- Raise money for the TAFE Directors Foundation a foundation launched in 2013 to raise money to assist disadvantaged students to undertake a VET course www.tda.edu.au
